The 'cha' ending is the possessive ending 'your'. It is used with nouns like those below from the siddur and Torah.

ך is a short form of שְׁלֶךָ.

The possessive 'your' or ך is added to the end of a noun when it is singular.

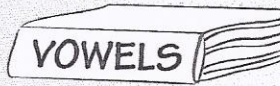

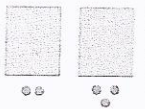
