Once again, BJEP will offer **two separate Family Services for each holiday**. Please note that children attending either service must be supervised by a responsible adult.

**For younger children and their parents, there will be a 45-minute, music-based, non-reading service in Schwartz Auditorium.** This service is recommended for children approximately 2 to 7 years old.

**For older children and their parents, there will be a reading service in the Levin Ballroom of the Usdan Student Center.** This service introduces the important prayers in Hebrew and in English translation, and features responsive reading in English, holiday songs, and the Torah reading. Recommended for children in Grades 2 and above, this service runs approximately one hour. BJEP 5th, 6th, and 7th grade students are invited to participate in the leading of this service. All assigned parts are in English and will be sent to readers in advance by email
